Dear Resident,

The City of Hugo Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Commission would like to invite you to share your thoughts on the reconstruction of Diamond Point Park (6355 145TH ST. N). In 2024, the City plans to replace the playground equipment, make concrete and asphalt repairs, improve the landscaping, and reconstruct the sport courts.

The Parks Commission would like you to share your input, ideas, and preferences for the Diamond Point Park Improvements at their meeting on **Wednesday, May 15** at 7:00 pm at the Peder Pedersen Pavilion. The pavilion is located across from City Hall at 5524 Upper 146th Street.

The existing play equipment will be removed and replaced utilizing the existing concrete curb and sidewalks. At the meeting, there will be four play equipment designers presenting several options. Residents will be asked to vote on their preferred design and color scheme. The Parks Commission will select a final playground design based on input received. In addition to sidewalk and trail repairs, the asphalt basketball court will be resurfaced. The sand volleyball court may be replaced by a fenced pickleball court. The Parks Commission would like residents to share whether they would like a pickleball court at Diamond Point Park in addition to selecting the playground equipment.
